Use of the logos and trademarks on the NCTA website is restricted. Please read the following brief explanation of how the marks and logos are to be used prior to downloading them.

In reference to the following logos and trademarks:

"NCTA" logo

"We Subscribe" logo and the "NCTA Guidelines/We Subscribe" mark

- You may use the above logos and trademarks on your institution's website, pamphlets, promotional materials, training manuals and other similar materials.
- You may place a text link to the NCTA web page on your institution or corporation website, provided the link is not a prominent feature on the site that confuses the reader as to proper ownership of the trademark(s). The link should have appropriate wording such as "This way to the NCTA web site."
- You must include the following attribution of ownership by NCTA of the trademark(s) within the website or document:

"The 'We Subscribe' logo and the 'NCTA Guidelines We Subscribe' mark, the 'We Participate' logo and the 'Consortium of College Testing Centers Participant' mark are service marks of National College Testing Association in the United States and are used by permission."

- You may not use any other logo or graphic to link to NCTA use only those provided on the NCTA website.
- You may not use any NCTA trademark in the title of your website or as a second-level domain name.
- You may not use any NCTA trademark in such a manner that it appears NCTA is legally associated with your
 organization, institution or company in any other manner other than the "We Subscribe" and "Participant"
 program participation.
- You may not place your institution or company name, trademarks, service marks, or product names next to (or combine them with) an NCTA service name.

Examples of appropriate usage of marks:

- "[Institution] subscribes to the NCTA Professional Standards and Guidelines."
- "We subscribe to the NCTA Professional Standards and Guidelines."
- "[Institution] is a Participant in the NCTA Consortium of College Testing Centers."
- "We participate in the NCTA Consortium of College Testing Centers."

<u>Note</u>: The above summary is an explanation of some of the provisions of the license restrictions and policies for NCTA marks, but the final word remains with the license agreement. If there is any conflict between this summary and the license, the license agreement terms prevail.
